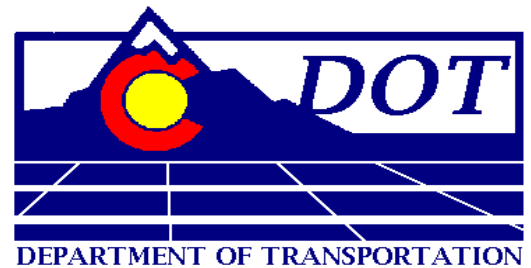

PUBLIC INVITED TO I-25/PLUM CREEK INTERCHANGE OPEN HOUSE

CASTLE ROCK – The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is inviting citizens to an open house regarding the upcoming Interstate 25 Widening and Plum Creek Interchange Reconstruction project.
