## ***New ramp open for Wednesday morning commute***

**CASTLE ROCK** – The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) will open the new ramp from Plum Creek Parkway to northbound Interstate 25 tomorrow night. However, the new ramp alignment will remain in a temporary configuration for about three more weeks as additional construction takes place on the northbound lanes of I-25.

Signs and electronic message boards will direct drivers to the new ramp and away from the current on-ramp from Wilcox Street to northbound I-25, which will be permanently closed.

The new ramp is part of the I-25/Plum Creek Parkway Interchange reconstruction project. It also includes widening northbound and southbound I-25 from two to three lanes between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Douglas Lane. All work is scheduled for completion in December 2009.
