Ramp set to reopen this afternoon

CASTLE ROCK – The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) will open the ramp from Plum Creek Parkway to southbound Interstate 25 at 5:00 this afternoon. It was closed to traffic on August 12, 2008, as part of the I-25/Plum Creek Parkway Interchange reconstruction project.

Some paving and other finishing work remains on the ramp, requiring a few more days of full ramp closures through November. As necessary, the ramp will be closed from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on weekdays. While the ramp is closed, drivers will need to use one of the following to access southbound I-25:

- West I-25 Frontage Road – south seven miles from Plum Creek Parkway to Tomah Road Interchange
- Wolfensberger Road Interchange – one mile north of Plum Creek Interchange

The project also includes widening northbound and southbound I-25 from two to three lanes between 5th Street and Douglas Lane. All work is scheduled for completion in December 2009.
